Another year has come and gone and once again it's time for OUR world famous **KNIGHTS OF COLUMBUS ANNUAL RUMMAGE SALE**. It's just a couple of weeks away on July 21. That's right, on **Saturday July 21**we'll be hosting the annual rummage sale, our biggest fundraiser of the year.

As we've come to find out over the years, there are three areas that we always need to make sure are covered to insure we have a successful sale.

#### They are:

- 1) Donation pick up's
- 2) Help the night before and the day of the sale
- 3) Clean up

The last several years we've been doing a great job taking care of all three areas. If you missed the signup sheet at our June meeting you can stop by classroom 6 any week night or on the weekend to assist with sorting of merchandise or just to socialize, we can always use the company.

Hopefully you've all been exercising and staying in shape in order to help **Friday night July 20 starting at 7:00 pm** in moving the merchandise from the classrooms to the carport which generally take 1 ½ to 2 hours. We also need help on Saturday morning July 21 at 7:00 am placing the merchandise on the tables and moving furniture to the designated area and then all hands on deck for the start of the sale at 9:00 am thru 1:00 pm (this year we're closing at 1:00 rather than 2:00) followed by clean up. If you'd like to work the whole day great, if that's too much I've tried to break up Saturday into two shifts 7:00 am to 11:00 am and 11:00 am until clean up is complete which is around 4:00 pm. We will again have the kitchen master chefs providing nutrition and refreshments to help keep us functioning at the top of our game.
